

# Sponsoring Veterinarians Process Overview

## Manitoba Community Vaccinator Program

#### **Step 1: Complete Veterinarian Application**

- Need to read Community Vaccination Sponsoring Veterinarian Educational Requirements
- Apply <u>here</u>
- Wait for Approval 1-5 business days

#### **Step 2: Identify Appropriate Community Vaccinator Candidate**

- Each sponsoring veterinarian can locate their own candidates
- contact the MVMA at <a href="mainto@mvma.ca">mvmainfo@mvma.ca</a> for help locating interested communities and/or potential vaccinators

#### Step 3: Apply to Utilize a Potential Community Vaccinator

- Read: Community Vaccinator Education Policy
- Complete: Manitoba Community Vaccinator Application
- Wait for approval 1-5 business days

## **Step 4: Complete and Record Community Vaccinator Training**

- Designated Vaccinator Education Record Template Microsoft Word doc
- Manitoba Community Vaccinator Programming: Designated Vaccinator Training Manual

#### Step 5: Create the Forms the Community Vaccinator Will Need

- Vaccination Consent Form Template Sample only in Word format
- Vaccination Record- Client Copy Template Microsoft Word doc
- Medical Record- DV/SV/Clinic Copy Template Microsoft Word doc
- Inventory Tracking Sheet Template Excel Format (Inventory Tracking Sheet Guide)
  - \*\*\* Please ensure that you are keeping records for the annual renewal. You will need to provide:
- Community where the vaccine was
  - administered
- Date vaccine(s) administered

- Name of animal owner or Animal Owner ID
- Name of animal or Animal ID
- Amount and type of vaccine administered
- For convenience, the page entitled Vaccine Usage from the Sample Vaccination Inventory Tracking document (template) can be used to easily track and provide this information annually.

# Step 6: Complete Annual Renewal (Complete Each November)

- Each year, the Sponsoring Veterinarian must:
  - 1) Complete a renewal application to maintain their Sponsoring Veterinarian status.
  - 2) Complete a renewal application for each Designated Vaccinator that they supervise.
  - 3) Submit to the MVMA Registrar information about services provided through the program.
